Thank you for enquiring about the Christian Friendship Fellowship.

The CFF started over 30 years ago as an organisation to put single Christians in touch with each other for friendship, and there are a good number of groups of single people now, although a few groups do have people who have met and married through CFF, mostly in positions of leadership.

There are groups over many parts of the British Isles, some larger, some smaller, and in a number of groups people tend to be in the middle-aged to older age bracket. Local groups arrange their own programmes and may include such things as meals out, rambles, Bible studies, meeting for coffee, visiting places of interest etc. In London, a meal is held in a central location once a month, sometimes with a walk or visit to a place of interest beforehand.

To keep members up-to-date, the "News and Views" booklet is sent out four times a year. It is a mixture of CFF news, ministry and events including programmes of groups and details of the group leader(s) to contact for more information.

Membership is available only to people who are both single – never been married; widowed, divorced or long-term separated - and Christian – from all denominations. At present it costs £10 per year, and a membership card and current copy of "News and Views" are sent out on receipt of the completed application form and fee.

An application form is available to download from our website (see the heading) so that you can fill it in and return it to me along with the £10 if you'd like to join.
