There are groups over many parts of the British Isles, some larger, some smaller, and in a number of groups people tend to be in the middle-aged to older age bracket. In London, a meal in a central venue is attended once a month.

As CFF membership has now been devolved to the local groups, they will admit new members and renew current membership once the coronavirus pandemic is over and people are allowed to meet socially once more.
